- The basic science behind climate change in line with the “ position of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC);
- The international, regional, national and local policy and legal frameworks to address climate change challenges and leverage opportunities;
- Mitigation and adaptation strategies to respond to climate change;
- Governance and management solutions to address climate change threats and opportunities; and
- The role of financial and other instruments to initiate and drive the adoption and implementation of mitigation and adaptation solutions.

- Relevant tertiary education in a field of environmental management; or
- Basic knowledge of/and relevant experience in a field of environmental management.
