



OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS – LEAD AUDITOR

(CEM-04.2.1)

COURSE OVERVIEW

This **SAATCA**-registered course focuses on transferring skills necessary to enable students to become qualified lead Occupational Health and Safety management system (OHSms) auditors. The course conforms to the international guidelines for auditing management systems (ISO 19011) and International requirements for certification bodies (ISO 17021).

This course will equip students with knowledge of the requirements of the auditing standards and the ability to successfully plan, execute and report on OHSms audits, as well as to act as lead auditors in OHS audits. OHSms requirements (based on OHSAS 18001/ISO 45001) and South African OHS legal requirements are used as auditing criteria.

Some of the key characteristics of this programme are:

- Down-to-earth and practical training techniques used to explain OHS auditing principles and techniques; and
- Demonstrations and role-play situations, using simulated case studies, OHS documentation and specific scenarios to practically exercise auditing skills and formulation of audit findings.
